- (b) Please be sure that the drawing has been drawn personally and has not been published in other newspapers or magazines.
- (c) All materials received will not be returned as a general rule.

(d) All materials received will become the property of JQA and may be used in publications or on the web for publicity and promotional purposes.

(e) Applications sent in groups, such as a school, should be sent in a single packet.

(f) Please note that drawing with text (such as posters) are not eligible for the contest.
